

## eMedicine PDA/Handheld

- eMedicine is a clinical information database providing review articles on specific medical conditions.
- Review articles include introduction, clinical, differentials, workup, treatment, medication, follow-up, and bibliography
- Continuously updated, evidence-based information.
- Medical topics cover medicine as well as specialty information.
- Includes online image database.

### Download Instructions

*Note: These instructions are for off-campus access, as you will need to synchronize the programs to your PDA at your PDA cradle.*

- 1) From the [PDA/Handheld section](#) on the [E-Databases webpage](#), select [eMedicine](#).  
Note: If you are not already connected via VPN, you will be prompted to login to ALADIN with your [Gwid](#) and last name.
- 2) Click on 'PDA and Wireless' from the main menu.
- 3) Download and install Mobipocket reader from the link provided. Once it has been installed, open the Mobipocket Reader on your PC.
- 4) Place your PDA in its cradle or connects its cord to your PC.
- 5) Add your PDA device to the Mobipocket application on your PC. (Click on "Tools", then "Install New Device" <either Windows Mobile Device or PalmOS Device >).
- 6) Download and review your eMedicine PDA content on your PC (e.g. - emerg.prc) and find it using the Mobipocket Reader. (Click on "File", then "Open" - navigate to the location of your eMedicine PDA content on your PC).
- 7) Send the eMedicine PDA content to your handheld device. (Highlight the eMedicine PDA content, click on "File", then "Send to Handheld" your PDA).
