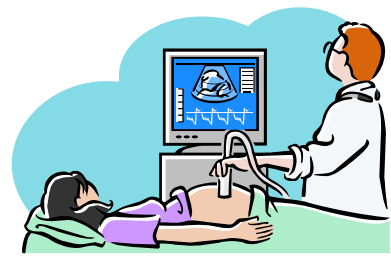


JOIN THE OB/GYN INTEREST GROUP
