The Virtual Exhibition will highlight innovations in clinical nursing, education, research, and leadership, with a particular focus on the health care needs of older adults and underserved individuals across the life span. Graduate nursing students, in addition to clinicians and faculty, are encouraged to apply. Selected works will be displayed in the virtual exhibition online during the month of April 2010.

ABSTRACT SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- ◆ Submit an abstract of 200 words or less (in narrative or outline form) via email to wrightsk@gwu.edu before March 19, 2010. Acceptable file formats include Microsoft Word or Adobe PDF.
- ◆ Please include the following information at the top of your submission:
 - a. Title of submission
 - b. Name of individual(s) submitting abstract
 - c. Employer, position title, and work address
 - d. Name of university if current student
 - e. Email address and phone number for primary contact person
 - f. Category of submission (clinical practice, education, research, or leadership)
 - g. Format of completed work (poster, paper, video, Power Point, podcast, webpage)
- ◆ Within your 200-word abstract, please make sure to include the following information:
 - a. A concise statement of the purpose of the submission
 - b. Background information and/or statement of the problem
 - c. A brief explanation of the process and/or methods
 - d. A summary of outcomes or results
 - e. Conclusions, next steps, and/or implications for practice
