2. **UNIV 982-** Students who started the program during spring 1998 or earlier who have completed all course work and have registered for the special project, residency or thesis must register for Continuous Enrollment to remain in status with the University if they have not completed the special project, residency or thesis.
3. **UNIV 992-** Students who wish to take some time off from their program may request a leave of absence. You must first complete a Petition Form and submit it to your faculty advisor. After your advisor approves your petition, please return it to the Office of Student Records, Ross Hall, Room, 222. You may register for leave of absence only after your petition has been approved.

Special Project, Practicum, or Culminating Experience Guidelines

We are in a transitional period where MPH students who started at different times need to register for different course numbers to do their Special Projects, Practicums, or Culminating Experiences. (We have three cohorts of students with different requirements.) The following guidance is to assist you in registering for the appropriate course number. This is not as complicated as it looks - simply find the category that applies to you!

PLEASE CLEAR IT WITH YOUR ADVISOR BEFORE REGISTERING FOR ANY SP, PRACTICUM, OR CULMINATING EXPERIENCE COURSE!!!!

** If you are a 36-credit MPH student (except Health Policy students and GH students doing a practicum): Register for PubH 212.10 - Special Project. Be sure to select the correct number of credits that matches your curriculum plan.

** If you are a 36-credit MPH Health Policy student: Register for PubH 212.11 (Special Project - 3 cr - This is the Health Policy seminar).

** If you are a 36-cr MPH Global Health Student registering for a Practicum rather than a Special Project: Register for PubH 209.28 (Practicum in GH & Devel, 3 cr).

** If you are a 45-credit MPH student (except Health Policy, Epi, and PH Management) who started last year (Sum05, Fall05, Spr06): Register for PubH 211.10. This is the integrated Practicum/Culminating Experience, for 4 credits. You should register for all 4 credits at once even if you are separating your practicum and culminating experience. You will get an IPG grade until both requirements are completed.

** If you are a 45-credit MPH Health Policy student):

- Register for PubH 214.16 (2 credits except by petition) for your Practicum
- Register for PubH 215.16 (3 credits) for your Culminating Experience (this is the Health Policy seminar).

** If you are a 45-credit MPH Epidemiology student who started last year (Sum05, Fall05, Spr06): You have an option to do either the integrated Practicum/Culminating Experience (PubH 211) or the separated Practicum and Culminating Experience (PubH 214.13 and PubH 215.13). You MUST talk with Prof. Ann Goldman before registering for either option.

** If you are a 45-credit MPH Public Health Management student:

- Register for PubH 214.20 (2 credits) for your Practicum
- Register for HSML 218 (2 credits) for your Culminating Experience (this the HSML seminar course).

** If you are a 45-credit MPH student who started in Summer or Fall 2006, you will register separately for your Practicum (PubH 214) and Culminating Experience (PubH 215). The SPHHS Course Schedule lists all Practicum course numbers with a section number corresponding to your major; be sure to choose the right section number. (Only a couple of PubH 215 sections are currently available for registration, because most new students are not yet ready to register for the Culminating Experience.)
