

## **GWU-EGPAF Partnership Research Assistant Position Description**

The George Washington University - Elizabeth Glaser Pediatric AIDS Foundation (EGPAF) Partnership for Pediatric AIDS and Public Health is currently seeking a research assistant to analyze existing data from a national program for HIV-exposed infants and young children in Rwanda.

The Research Assistant's responsibilities will be to conduct preliminary analyses of an existing database of prospective nutrition data for HIV-exposed infants and young children who participated in a national feeding program in Rwanda. The RA will analyze the data using indicators of growth and nutritional status and draft a report of findings.

The RA will work under the direction of personnel in EGPAF's Research Department and the GWU-EGPAF Partnership Executive Coordinator.

This is a part-time, hourly position (\$14/hour) at the Research Assistant level. The anticipated duration is approximately 6-8 weeks. This project may be used to complete the CE requirement for qualifying students.

### **Requirements:**

1. Bachelor's degree and enrollment in the GWU SPHHS Epidemiology or Biostatistics MPH program
2. Strong organizational skills
3. Quantitative analysis skills, including previous experience working with Access
4. Ability to work independently
5. Knowledge of HIV in an international context preferred
6. Interest in nutrition preferred
