**Faculty Position –  
Public Health Communication and Social Marketing**

The George Washington University Department of Prevention and Community Health is seeking qualified behavioral scientists to fill a tenure-eligible faculty position. Rank will be at the Assistant or Associate Professor level, depending on applicant experience. Responsibilities of the positions will include teaching graduate courses in the degree programs of the Department (MPH and DrPH); undertaking scholarship and obtaining external funding in the specific area of expertise; advising students in graduate public health educational programs; and broadly contributing to the research, service, and educational mission of the Department.

**Basic qualifications:** Applicants must have an earned doctoral degree or equivalent, experience in a behavioral or social science discipline and scholarly accomplishments in the relevant discipline. Applicants should also have experience in cross-disciplinary research approaches and a demonstrated record of successful teaching at the graduate level.

**Preferred qualifications:** Preference will be given to applicants who have a track record of scholarly activities in the areas of communication and social marketing as it applies to public health, and in particular to fields such as tobacco control, HIV/AIDS, obesity prevention, and reproductive health; familiarity with community-based participatory and health disparities research; experience in global health; evidence of leadership or leadership potential in their discipline, potential to obtain external funding and strong verbal and written English communications skills.

**To Apply:** Qualified individuals should send the following documents (electronic submission preferred): 1) current curriculum vitae; 2) statement of teaching and research experience; 3) evidence of scholarship including recent first-authored or co-authored, peer-reviewed publications; and 4) names and contact information of three references, to be addressed to:
