

**Associate or Full Professor

The George Washington University School of Public Health and Health Services is seeking applicants for a position at the associate or full professor level for its Department of Health Policy. The Department focuses on all aspects of U.S. health policy and prepares students to analyze health policy matters in the real world, taking maximum advantage of its location in Washington, D.C.

The Department seeks a senior faculty member with strong experience in health policy and considerable skills in the methods of health policy analysis and research. Rank and salary are commensurate with experience, and the position is tenure or tenure track. The individual who holds this position will, in close collaboration with other senior and junior faculty and researchers, help lead the Department's educational program in health policy at the masters and doctoral levels. In addition, this individual will assume a leadership role in extramurally funded research and will be actively engaged in governance and service at the Departmental, School, and Medical Center levels.

**Basic Qualifications:** Applicants must hold a doctoral degree in health policy or health services research or must have doctoral level disciplinary training that has led to a developed and recognized expertise in health policy or health services research. In addition, applicants should possess a national reputation in the field of health policy or health services research. Candidates should have substantial expertise in one or more of the following areas: health care financing and health insurance reform; the public policy making process; the federal budget process; and the interaction of the political process with health policy development. Experience in applied health policy formulation, development, and implementation is essential. Experience in teaching at the graduate level is also essential.

**Preferred Qualifications:** Applicants should demonstrate the requisite areas of expertise as well as: (1) a demonstrated commitment to teaching, scholarship, service, and leadership; (2) a demonstrated capacity to engage in interdisciplinary collaboration in health policy or health services research; and (3) a demonstrated capacity to secure extramural support for health policy or health services research. Research interests and areas of expertise in which the Department has a particular interest include, but are not limited to, public and private health finance, technology and innovation in personal health care, global health, and the practice and science of population health and medical care.
