



## FACULTY POSITIONS

The Department of Health Services Management and Leadership (HSML) within the School of Public Health and Health Services at The George Washington University is seeking applicants for faculty positions in health services management and operations at the full, associate, or assistant professor level. The department offers a CAHME-accredited Master of Health Services Administration (MHSA) Degree.

The mission of the HSML Department is to prepare future leaders to manage health services organizations such as hospitals, medical group practices, and post acute care facilities. HSML graduates are well prepared to address the ongoing challenges of the changing health care delivery environment and hold leadership positions in major health care organizations throughout the country. The Program includes a required, year-long residency (or other appropriate internship) as well as significant emphasis on financial management and quality assurance.

**Basic requirements** include an earned doctorate in health services organization management, health services research, business administration, economics, or other appropriate social science discipline. The successful candidate is also expected to advise students in course work for the Master of Health Services Administration and Master of Public Health Management Degree programs.

**Preferred qualifications** include teaching experience, a strong track record in management in health services, and a demonstrated ability to conduct research in a field of health services management.

Rank, salary and employment in either a tenure or non-tenure track position will be commensurate with qualifications and experience.
