**Assistant Professor – Associate Professor – Professor**

The Department of Global Health of The George Washington University School of Public Health and Health Services invites applications for four faculty positions specializing in: Quantitative Policy Analysis, Health Services Management; and Program Design, Monitoring and Evaluation.

These positions will be tenure-earning or non-tenure earning faculty positions at the Assistant, Associate, or Professor level. The rank will be commensurate upon qualification.

**Basic Qualifications:** Applicants must have either a doctoral degree in an appropriate public health, management or medical discipline, strong verbal and written communication skills, and a record of peer-reviewed scientific publications.

**Preferred Qualifications:** Applicants should have professional experience in two or more regions of the world and experience in at least one developing region or sub-region; a track record in teaching, supervising graduate students, developing funded research; and will be available to travel and engage in international research and teaching collaborations.

Additional Preferred qualifications include:

- *For the Health Services Management Faculty Position*, a foundation and substantial implementation experience in health systems management, design, quality assurance and/or sectoral/program level financing;
- *For the Quantitative Policy Analyst Faculty Position*, quantitative skills and a research interest in the dynamics and control of the global burden of disease, estimating and modeling policy and/or program interventions in public health;
- *For the Program Design, Monitoring and Evaluation Faculty Position (Washington, D.C. based)*, project and program evaluation expertise in a key public health domain including reproductive and adolescent health; maternal and child health; environmental and occupational health; nutrition and/or HIV/AIDS.
- *For the Program Design, Monitoring and Evaluation Faculty Position (East Africa based)*, demonstrated experience in developing research and teaching programs in resource limited settings; strong team-building and methodological skills; and expertise in a relevant public health domain.

**Application Procedure:** Highly motivated individuals with appropriate backgrounds are encouraged to apply. Interested applicants should submit the following documents electronically: 1) a curriculum vitae; 2) a statement of research interests and accomplishments and plans for maintaining or developing an independently-funded research program; and 3) a statement of teaching and mentoring experience. Only complete applications will be considered. Review of applications will begin on 11 February 2008 and continue until the positions are filled.
