The George Washington University School of Public Health and Health Services seeks an associate professor (tenure-track) for its Department of Health Policy. The individual who holds this position will occupy a central position in the Department. Responsibilities of the position include the day-to-day management of the Hirsh Health Law and Policy Program, the Department's embedded health law and policy program that oversees the Department's law-related health policy research activities as well as its legal education activities. The individual will be expected to teach health law and policy across the field of health law, mentor students, and collaborate with the Department's other health policy researchers in the design and conduct of research efforts that contain a legal dimension.

Qualifications: Applicants must hold a JD degree and have extensive experience in the field of health law (10 years or more). Applicants must be highly experienced teachers and academic administrators, as well as collaborators in multi-disciplinary research efforts. Applicants must have a strong record of teaching and student mentorship, as well as be able to demonstrate evidence of scholarship and collaboration.
