The George Washington University School of Public Health and Health Services seeks an assistant professor (tenure-track) for its Department of Health Policy. The individual who holds this position will occupy a central position in the Department and the School. Responsibilities of the position include teaching introductory and advanced health policy analysis; mentoring masters and doctoral level candidates; and collaborating on the development of a robust research and scholarship agenda for the department in the field of health care quality and health disparities.

Basic Qualifications: Applicants must hold a doctoral degree in public policy, public health, or health policy or hold a terminal degree in a related field (such as a JD or MD). Applicants must have experience teaching masters level courses and must be able to demonstrate excellence in teaching through student teaching evaluations or other evidence. Applicants must also demonstrate promise in health research related to health care quality and health disparities by the securing of relevant research awards and publication in refereed journals.

Preferred Qualifications: Preference will be given to candidates who can demonstrate involvement in policy development or evaluation in the field of health disparities; a demonstrated ability to secure, administer, and direct extramural support in the areas of health care quality and health disparities; a record of developing masters level courses on health policy related to quality and disparities; and experience mentoring masters and doctoral students in these fields.
